

## **Health and Safety Face Painting Policy**

To protect the health of our staff and of those getting painted, we won't be able to face paint you if you are currently sick, experiencing any Covid symptoms, have any open cuts, grazes, wounds or have been in contact with anyone who has Covid symptoms or has tested positive for Covid within the last 14 days.

We do not paint children under the age of 3 years, unless they have a skin test after which we will only paint their arm as per the manufacturer's guidelines.

We are so sorry for the inconvenience, but we want to keep everyone safe and healthy. We really appreciate your co-operation with our Health and Safety Policy.

To take part in face painting please follow our steps below.

1. All adults are to wear a mask
2. Please sanitise your hands before taking part
3. All faces/arms to be wiped with a baby wipe before being painted.

### **What we do to keep you safe!**

- Fully Certified in the Covid-19 Specific infection control course through the Beauty Guild.
- Sanitise our hands, aprons and workstations between customers
- Wear the appropriate PPE to keep everyone safe.
- Clean water per customer.
- Single use of brushes and sponges per customer.
- No double dipping in paints (single use of brushes and sponges only)
- Full cleaning and sanitisation of brushes after each customer. Brushes are washed with soap and water and then dipped in 70% alcohol and left to dry before using again.
- All face paints are professional cosmetic grade and EU and FDA approved for use on the skin. Paints contain antimicrobial properties.
- We spray our paints with special makeup sanitiser to keep them hygienic.
- Each face painter holds full PL Insurance and a detailed risk assessment.
