

Health and Safety Face Painting Policy

To protect the health of our staff and of those getting painted, we won't be able to face paint you if you are currently sick, experiencing any Covid symptoms, have tested positive for Covid 19 or have any open cuts, grazes or wounds.

We do not paint children under the age of 3 years unless, the parent/guardian is happy that the child has had a face paint before and is not allergic due to sensitive skin. If a child under 3 years has never been face painted we will only paint them after a skin test (a small amount of paint applied on the underside of the wrist) Please wait at least 15 mins to see if a reaction occurs. If there are no signs of irritation we are happy to paint them.

To save you time - If your child requires a skin test please come to the front of the queue to request one, you can then get in to the queue whilst you wait for your result.

We really appreciate your co-operation with our Health and Safety Policy.
To take part in face painting all faces/arms to be wiped with a baby wipe before being painted.

What we do to keep you safe!

- Fully Certified in the Covid-19 Specific infection control course through the Beauty Guild.
- Sanitise our hands between customers.
- Regularly sanitise our workstations.
- Wear the appropriate PPE to keep everyone safe.
- Clean water per customer.
- Single use of sponges per customer.
- Full cleaning and sanitisation of brushes after each customer. Brushes are washed with soap and water and then dipped in 70% alcohol and left to dry before using again.
- All face paints are professional cosmetic grade and EU and FDA approved for use on the skin. Paints contain antimicrobial properties.
- We regularly spray our paints with special makeup sanitiser to keep them hygienic.
- Each face painter holds full PL Insurance and a detailed risk assessment.
